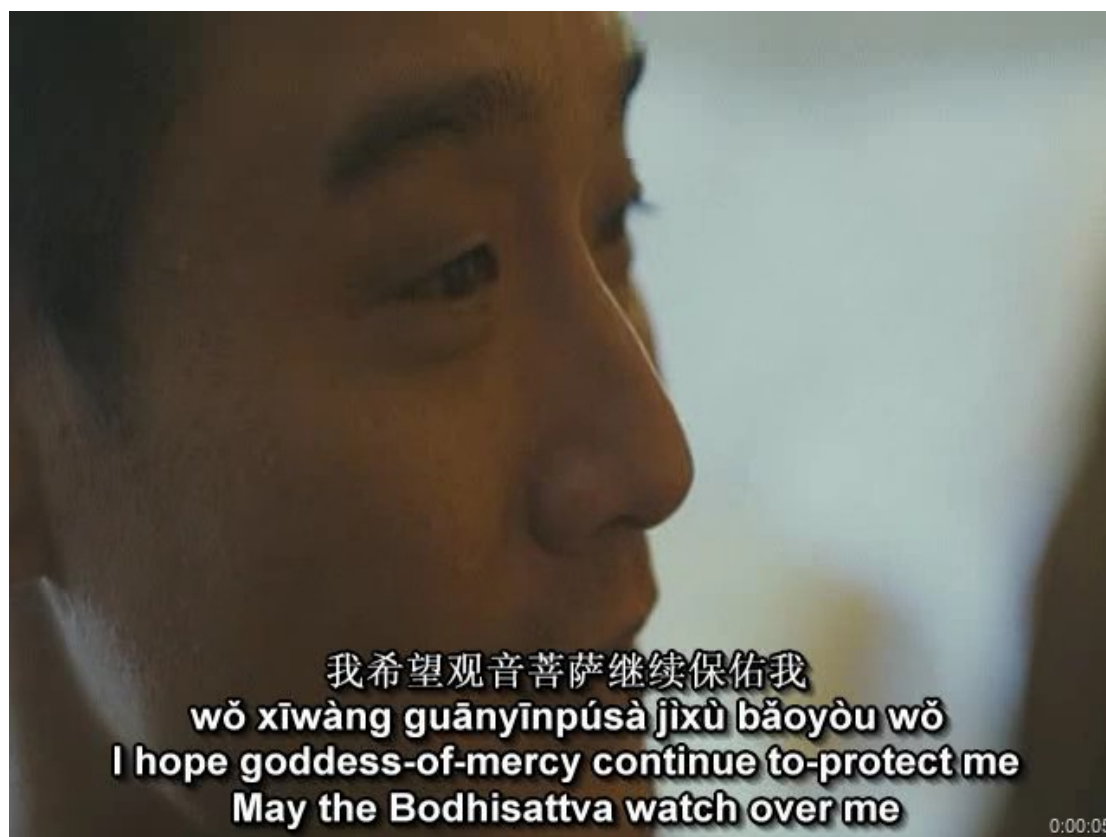


## Lesson Thirty-Two: Praying to Buddha
